Hope Anglican Fellowship is one of the many new, independent Anglican churches being started around the country in response to the Episcopal Church's departure from the authority of scripture and the catholic faith. We have applied for affiliation with the Anglican Communion Network* through which we will receive episcopal oversight.

Hope Anglican Fellowship is temporarily worshipping with Christ the King Reformed Episcopal Church. At the right time, the Fellowship will call a priest and become a stand-alone congregation within the Anglican Communion Network equipped to carry out the Great Commission as part of a new wave of Anglican Communion churches in North America.
