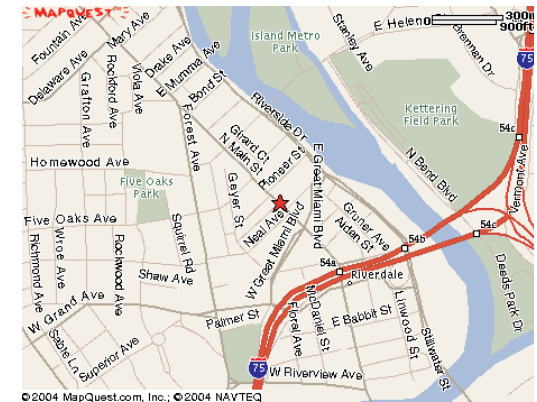
July 10: Hope - Its Biblical basis and why we chose it as our name
